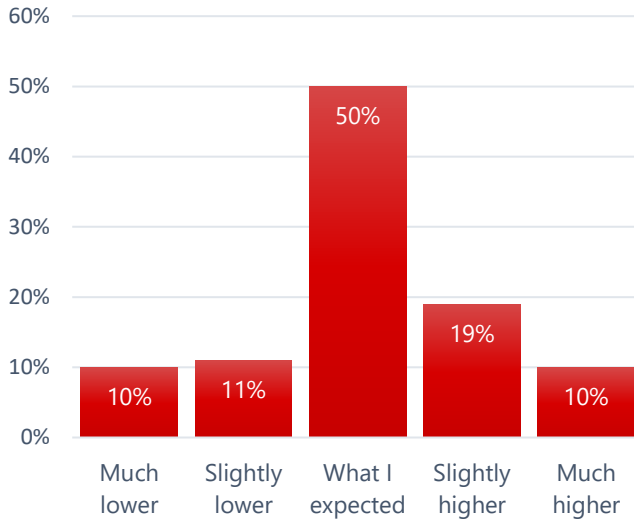

By increasing the amount now with COVID the government is acknowledging that the base amount is not sufficient to live on.

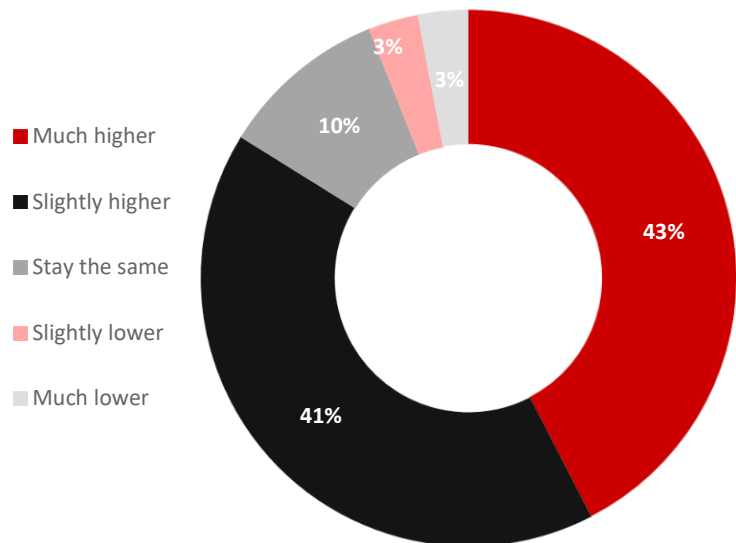


People in need deserve an income that allows them to meet their needs with dignity and supports their future.
