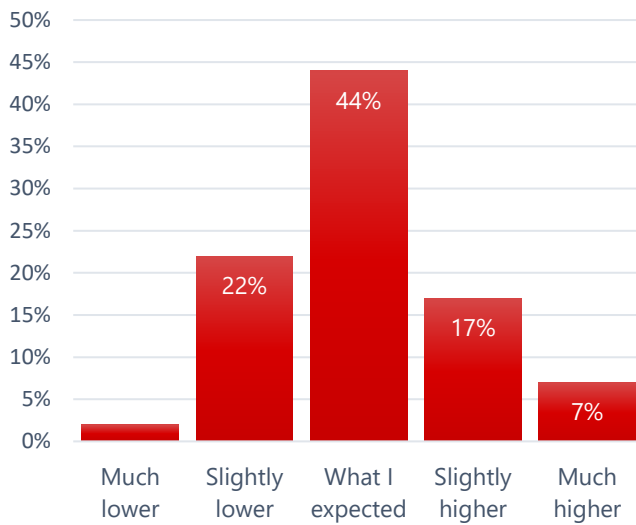

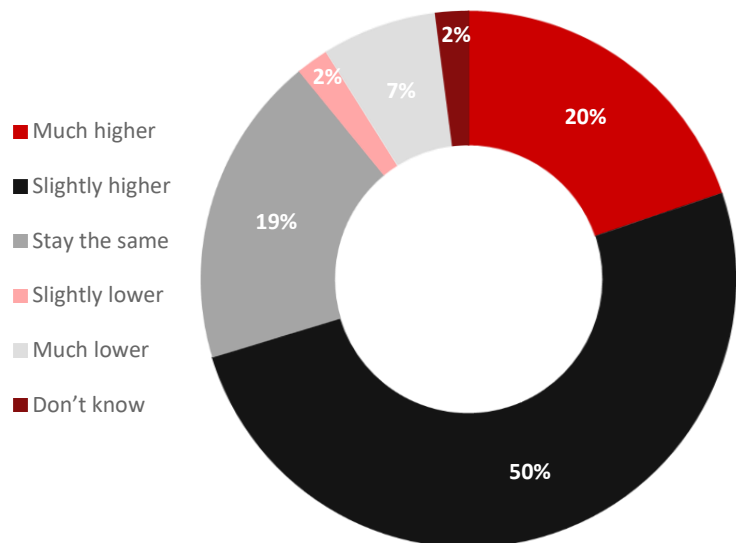


Respondents in Hasluck think the base rate of JobSeeker should be:
