What is Bridges?

Bridges Disability Support program offers a multitude of community-based programs and other services to people who have a disability.

Bridges can be accessed by people who either have a funded package through NDIS or other funding sources such as the Insurance Commission of WA. Where such funding is not available, a fee for service can be discussed to access services or compliment an existing service with more hours or days.

Our approach

We are committed to providing individualised and small group supports to all people who access our service, with the goal and outcome that each person can be supported to live their best life. Upon initial engagement we spend quality time talking with participants and their family to understand what they want out of life and how we can help them achieve that.

Our participants are involved in all stages of the decision making. This may include choosing their support team or interaction in planning meetings.

We offer a flexible range of services including:

- ◆ Personal support with daily living activities
- ◆ Supported learning working towards volunteering or employment
- ◆ Community support
- ◆ Breaks away with supported holidays
- ◆ Mentoring
- ◆ Support to establish independent living
- ◆ Overnight and weekend social support
- ◆ Planning and coordination
- ◆ Private contractual arrangements
