What is the Albany Women's Centre?

The Albany Women's Centre provides support to women and children affected by family and domestic violence. Our services include:

- crisis accommodation
- 24 hour on call service
- development of safety plans
- assistance and support

- information and advocacy
- outreach support services
- referrals to other agencies
- links to housing, income, legal and medical services

What is family and domestic violence?

Family and domestic violence is when one person in a relationship uses abusive behavior in order to control the other person. Some ways this can happen are:

- hitting, punching or pushing you, slapping, kicking and choking
- threatening to hurt your friends, family members or pets
- putting you down in front of others
- making you feel stupid and worthless, insults, threats, intimidation
- making you have sex when you don't want to
- not letting you go out, or contact friends or family
- not letting you have money for food, clothing or other basic needs
- not allowing you to attend church, making fun of your beliefs









Some of the effects of Family & Domestic Violence are:

• shame missing work and/or school

• low self esteem depression

• isolation • feeling alone

physical injuries • no confidence

• inability to trust people • feeling nervous
