What is the Albany Women's Centre?

The Albany Women's Centre provides support to women and children affected by family and domestic violence. Our services include:

- Crisis accommodation
- 24 hour on call service
- Development of safety plans
- Assistance and support
- Information and advocacy
- Outreach support services
- Referrals to other agencies
- Housing, income, legal, medical services info

Family and domestic violence is when one person in a relationship uses abusive behaviour to control the other person, such as:

- Hitting, punching or pushing you, slapping, kicking and choking
- Threatening to hurt your friends, family members or pets
- Putting you down in front of others
- Making you feel stupid and worthless, insults, threats, intimidation
- Making you have sex when you don't want to
- Not letting you go out, contact friends or family
- Not letting you have money for food, clothing or other basic needs
- Not allowing you to attend church, making fun of your beliefs



Effects of family and domestic violence:

- Shame
- Low self esteem
- Isolation and feeling alone
- Physical injuries
- Inability to trust people
- Missing work and/or school
- Depression
- Feeling nervous
