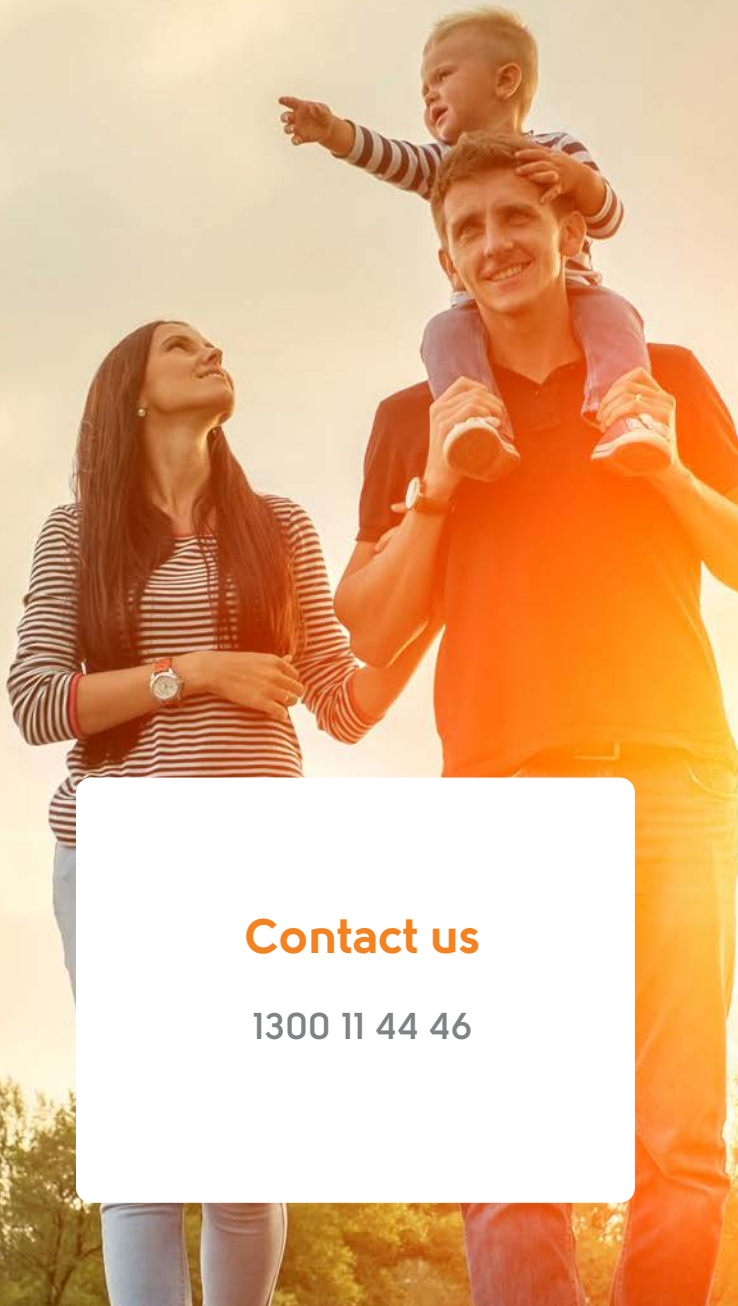

What is Making Ends Meet?

Making Ends Meet provides financial assistance, support and education to working families who are living in private rental accommodation and experiencing significant 'housing stress'.

Making Ends Meet can help you to:

- ♥ pay bills
- ♥ negotiate repayment plans
- ♥ budget and manage your finances
- ♥ find other useful services

Making Ends Meet is for you if you are:

- ♥ a family renting privately (not through public housing) experiencing housing stress or tenancy is at risk
- ♥ working
- ♥ in stable accommodation for six months or more
- ♥ living in the South West Metro area or Great Southern area
- ♥ linked with an Anglicare WA Financial Counsellor or Housing Support Worker

The First Step

You can phone Making Ends Meet on **1300 11 44 46** during business hours.

How Does It Work?

There is an initial assessment to talk about your financial situation. If Making Ends Meet is suitable for you, a support worker will help to arrange an action plan and will work with you providing budgeting support until your situation is stable.
