What is Financial Counselling?

Financial Counselling helps people work through any problems they are having with money. This may include managing a household budget, negotiating outstanding bills, or saving for the future. Anglicare WA's Financial Counsellors not only help solve immediate problems, but teach people how to maintain their own financial stability independently.

Our Financial Counsellors are qualified to:

- Make assessments of financial situations
- Provide information and options to address financial problems
- Assist with resolutions if necessary
- Advocate and negotiate with creditors
- Make referrals to other useful services in the community
- Provide information about government assistance that may be available
- Support clients in developing their own budget
- Relay relevant information about consumer credit and bankruptcy



Confidentiality

All Financial Counsellors are bound by an oath of confidentiality in relation to counselling sessions. However please note all Anglicare WA employees have a legal responsibility to report concerns if we believe the well-being or safety of a client, employee or community member is at risk.
