

Adult Housing & Homelessness Services



Housing case management support for adults in the South West Metro and Peel regions, who are experiencing homelessness or difficulty sustaining a private rental.

Anglicare WA have the following services offering support when you're faced with homelessness or experiencing difficulties keeping your current private rental accommodation.

Supported Tenancy Anglicare WA Rockingham (STAR)

Service area: Rockingham/Kwinana & surrounds

The STAR service can assist you to sustain your private rental. A Housing Case Manager can help you to create a plan to rectify rent arrears, advocate on your behalf and refer you to appropriate services to help address other issues impacting your tenancy.

Homelessness

Service area: Southwest Metropolitan

If you are staying in a refuge, transitional housing or experiencing any form of homelessness, a Housing Case Manager can help you explore your housing options and link into appropriate services including health, education and counselling to manage issues impacting your ability to obtain safe, stable and affordable accommodation.



Private Tenancy Support Service area: Southwest Metropolitan

If you are renting through a real estate or private landlord, a Housing Case Manager can support you to sustain your tenancy if you're at risk of becoming homeless.

Alcohol & Other Drugs Housing Support Service area: Southwest Metropolitan & Peel

A Housing Case Manager can work with you towards securing or maintaining appropriate accommodation when receiving treatment to manage drug and/or alcohol issues and are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

Family Housing

Service area: Greater Perth Metropolitan

If your family are at risk of or experiencing homelessness, with two or more children under the age of 16 in your care, you may be eligible for the service. We provide weekly home visits in our medium-term transitional housing for families who actively engage in a support plan. Contact us to find out more about eligibility.

Please note: During periods of high demand, the waitlist may be closed to new applicants.
