We work with families and individuals experiencing chronic homelessness in the Bunbury area.

Keny Miya works alongside people to secure long term, stable housing to meet their needs. We can advocate and refer to housing providers including private rentals, community housing and Department of Communities housing.

We understand that securing a home is just the first step and we are there to support people to maintain their tenancy and work with them throughout their journey.

In collaboration with local community services, we work together to offer a range of services for people based on their individual needs.
