## What is Private Tenancy Support?

Private Tenancy Support is for you if you are:

- renting privately (not through public housing)
- living in the South West Metropolitan or Great Southern areas
- at risk of losing your tenancy which may include rent arrears, breach or termination notices, or issues with maintenance

## Private Tenancy Support can:

- help negotiate with landlords
- advocate on your behalf
- help with budgeting
- provide tenancy information
- provide information on Centerlink payments and benefits
- provide referrals to other services

## The first step

You can phone the Private Tenancy Support Program to make an appointment.

You may also be referred to Private Tenancy Support, with your permission, by any organisation or agency including the Department of Communities, Centrelink, a real estate agent/property manager or via your church or social worker, by phoning the relevant number on the back of this brochure.

## Helping you to stabilise your housing and negotiate on your behalf



## How does It work?

You have an initial meeting with a Housing Support Worker, in which you can talk about your rental situation. If this program is suitable for you, a support worker will help you arrange an action plan and assist you until your situation is stable.
