Anglicare WA services offer support when you're faced with homelessness or experiencing difficulties keeping your current private rental accommodation.


Supported Tenancy Anglicare WA Rockingham (STAR)

Service Area: Rockingham/Kwinana and surrounds

We provide support and advocacy to people renting through Real Estate or a private landlord and find it difficult to maintain their tenancy. A Housing Case Manager helps to access other services before debt or tenancy issues become unmanageable or the eviction process starts. The Case Manager works with you until the tenancy is stabilised.

Private Tenancy Support

Service Area: Southwest Metropolitan A Housing Case Manager can help sustain your tenancy if you are



renting through a real estate or private landlord and are at risk of homelessness. They can help negotiate with landlords and property managers, provide basic budgeting information, advocacy and referrals to other services including Financial Counselling to address larger debt.

Making Ends Meet

Service Area: WA Statewide service for people engaging with an Anglicare WA Housing Case Manager or Financial Counsellor We provide financial assistance, support and education to families living in private rental accommodation, where someone in the household is employed. If the service is deemed suitable, a Housing Case Manager or Anglicare WA Financial Counsellor helps arrange an action plan and works with you to provide budgeting support until your situation is stable.
