Community services exist to assist people in need. Many community services are run by not-forprofit organisations and may be accessed free of charge. They can help with a large variety of problems and are available across Western Australia.

There are community services that can assist you with:

- Financial problems, such as:

- Relationship problems, such as:
  - $\circ$  separation
  - o conflict
  - o domestic violence
  - Housing problems, such as
    - maintaining a tenancy
    - o learning independent living skills
    - o finding a place to stay
- Personal problems, such as
  - o depression and anxiety
  - o the effects of abuse
