What does it involve?

There are many different types of services available for alcohol and other drug treatments. This pamphlet will give a brief description of the types of services that are available to you. These descriptions are very general and do not specify the exact details of each agency. That is why it is important for you to call and talk to a worker at each of these agencies to make sure that the service is suitable for you.

The first step may be to call the Alcohol and other Drugs Information Service (ADIS) line, they can give you helpful advice on any drug and alcohol information that you may need. It is a confidential 24 hour counselling, information and referral line.

Counselling

Professional counselling services provide a range of individual and group interventions which enable individuals, couples and families to address drug use issues. Counselling is available on the telephone or in person. Counselling services are also available if you don't want to quit your drug use. Counselling services that are offered can also be formal or informal depending on the agency.

Detoxification

This option is for people who would like to withdraw from drugs. This can be done with or without medical assistance. You can detox at home or at a residential service. Home detoxification can include experienced nurses working closely with your local doctor and regularly visiting you at home throughout your withdrawal. This detox is usually medically assisted, but each case is assessed on an individual basis. This may also involve detoxing in a regulated manner at a particular centre. These centres help you to manage your withdrawal safely.

Rehabilitation

Rehabilitation programs are varied. Many rehabilitation programs are located in rural areas. Rehabilitation programs require attendees to commit to the service for a certain time period, depending on the programs requirements. These rehabilitation programs do sometimes have a cost, but this is minimal and is usually deducted from your Centrelink payment.

There are also rehabilitation programs that run in the metropolitan areas. These generally have the same requirements as the rural programs. Rehabilitation programs have an initial assessment and there may be a waiting list for the program. It may also be requirement for entry in to the rehabilitation program that you are not intoxicated at the time of admittance. This usually means detoxing before going to the program.

Sobering Up

These are centres where you can go when you are intoxicated and need some time-out. They usually provide you with a feed and a shower.

Alcohol and Other Drug Treatment Services
