Course Overview:

This one day workshop looks at the various dilemmas human service workers face every day and identifies strategies for dealing with these dilemmas in an ethically appropriate and safe way. It will focus on issues such as duty of care, the expectations of agencies and clients, confidentiality and the limits of information disclosure.

A range of case situations will be used to allow participants to grapple with the ethical dilemmas they are routinely face in their own work place, to assist them to make the decisions required in complex case situations.

Who is this course suitable for?

This workshop is suitable for workers within the community and human services.

By the end of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Canvas the ethical dilemmas they face in their work life
- Reflect on the ethical precepts that guide their own practice
- Understand the expectations of agencies, clients and the community
- Discuss the issues that ethical dilemmas pose for them
- Gain an understanding of what confidentiality is and is not
- Use a range of case examples relevant to their respective work environments to ascertain appropriate management
- Identify a range of strategies they can use for resolving the ethical dilemmas
