Expression of Interest

Background

In September 2020, the Sambell Centre, our building at 23 Adelaide Terrace, became home to our corporate office as well as a range of community services. Of the 55 locations from which we deliver services, the Sambell Centre is the only location owned by Anglicare WA.

Its large western wall provides a canvas to start conversations: to shift community attitudes towards compassion and hope, in line with our advocacy priorities and values which can be viewed at www.anglicarewa.org.au/who-we-are/advocacy

Expressions of Interest

We are seeking expressions of interest by 29 November 2020 from artists interested in painting a mural on the western wall of 23 Adelaide Terrace, as pictured below.

Expressions of interest should include:

- A paragraph about a proposed concept and how it connects with our advocacy priorities and values;
- Examples of the artist's previous relevant work;
- A quote, including cost of all materials and artist fee to complete the mural; and
- A timeline of how long you will need to complete the work.

It is anticipated that this project will include an artist's fee of \$20,000-\$30,000, depending on the artists experience and size of the mural.

Please note that the size of the wall is approximately 530sqm. Please outline in your expression of interest what portion of the wall your proposed artwork would occupy. If you do not propose to paint the entire wall, please specify the area and size in square meters that your proposed artwork would be.

Process

After receiving Expressions of Interest, the Anglicare WA Executive team will choose three artists who will be invited to produce a design of their proposed artwork for a fee of \$750 each.

The project will be awarded to one of the three finalists based on the designs submitted and perceived fit with our advocacy priorities and values.

It is anticipated that work will begin in early 2021, subject to funding availability.
